Pacific Paradise State School information procedure for Nambour District **School Sport trials.**

For information regarding Nambour District School sport trials, this is the procedure we will be following at school for students and parents interested in receiving the trial information and have the playing experience or skill levels necessary to trial.

The Nambour District School Sport 2023 District 10-12 years Trial Calendar is posted on our Pacific Paradise School website and a copy has been displayed in all year 5 & 6 classrooms.

When trial information for each sport is received by the school it is placed on the Pacific Paradise website. Mr Franklin goes to each year 5 & 6 classroom and hands out the trial information for that sport to students who have previous high-level playing experience in that sport and/or display the skills to a representative level. This information is also placed in each classroom for students who are absent.

The District Trial Permission Slip is also on the Pacific Paradise Website and is given to interested students. This form must be signed by the Principal, Mr Carter and by Mr Franklin for the student to have permission from the school to attend the trials. This form must be handed in at the trials.

For each Nambour District trial there is a QR scan code which must be completed by the due date for your child's nomination to trial, to be accepted. This information is on each individual Nambour District Sport trial information sheet. All children MUST register on line to trial.

The Mouthguard Consent - District Trials Form is also on the Pacific Paradise Website and is given to students who are trialling for the sports of AFL, rugby league, rugby union and hockey. This form must be handed in at the trials. No Form No Trials.
