This funding will be used to

- All students will achieve the National Minimum Standard in Literacy and Numeracy in 2015 or have an evidence-based plan to address their specific learning needs.
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands NAPLAN in Year 3 Reading from 25.8% in 2013 to 35.0% in 2015 and in Year 5 Numeracy from 14.8% in 2014 to 22.0% in 2015.

Our strategy will be to

Use a continuous process in focus areas (Reading, Grammar and Punctuation, Writing and Spelling and Number) to assess students' current performance; teach to the needs of students; and re-assess students to monitor improvement.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing an early Years Pedagogical Coach (0.5) to work with Prep to Year 2 teachers and a Pedagogical Coach (0.5) to work with Years 3 to 6 teachers to develop and embed consistent Standards of Practice in Reading, Spelling, Writing and Number.
- Implementing intensive support programs in Reading, Writing, Speaking and Number for students below the Literacy and Numeracy National Minimum Standards.
- Developing additional strategies to improve student attendance and learning engagement.
- Implementing extension programs to maximise outcomes for students in Literacy and Numeracy.
